## Dalit Ziv, musician

Dalit started her educational path, in 1988, studying music performance and composition in Rimon, the highly acclaimed School of contemporary music in Israel. She was mastering as a Jazz flute player and as a composer. Then, Dalit attended Lesley College in Cambridge, U.S. and got her Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies.

Soon after graduating she went back to Israel and started working as an assistant director in a local Theater in Tel Aviv, then moving onto the movie industry. After working as an assistant director for several movie productions she decided to get deeper into the creative process. In 1998 Ms. Ziv joined a new initiative and established an alternative documentary women's show called 'Women's Talk'. She soon became one of two women producers, who gathered women from different parts of society, enabling them to collaborate together on the screen.

All those years she always had special time for creating music. Nowadays, Dalit sees music as her main interest and passion, especially composing her own music, starting from instrumental music, adding to it her own lyrics. Musical material started to pile up.

'Suggestions to the unconscious' was her debut album, working with Shai Levinshtein as a musical producer. The album was complete in 2014.

In 2016 Ms. Ziv was touring with her live show, the unplugged version of her songs, Dalit on vocals and flute, accompanying by Alon Marcus on the classical guitar.
